Nut and Fragrance Free School

At Our Lady of Good Counsel CES, there are members in our school community with severe life-threatening allergies, especially to nuts and fragrances. Anaphylaxis is a



medical condition that causes a severe reaction to specific foods and fragrances and can result in death within minutes. As this affects the entire school community, we are requesting that you not send any lunches or snacks with your child to school that contain the allergen, e.g., peanuts/nuts. This includes Nutella. Please also be aware of and do not use anything scented as it will cause a



reaction. Please make sure that all of your children's caregivers are aware of the food and fragrance restrictions. If you have any questions, please contact your child's teacher. Thank you

for your understanding and cooperation.

Safe Arrival/School Messenger



At Our Lady of Good Counsel CES, one of our greatest priorities is ensuring that all our students arrive safely to school every day. With **SafeArrival**, you are asked to report your child's absence in advance using any of these 3 convenient methods:

- 1. Using your mobile device, download and install the **SchoolMessenger app** from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store (or from the links at https://go.schoolmessenger.ca). The first time you use the app, select **Sign Up** to create your account. Select **Attendance** then **Report an Absence**.
- 2. Use the SafeArrival website, https://go.schoolmessenger.ca. The first time you use the website, select **Sign Up** to create your account. Select **Attendance** then **Report an Absence**.
- 3. Call the toll-free number 1 (855) 856-7862 to report an absence using the automated phone system.

These options are available 24 hours/day, 7 days a week. Future absences can be reported at any time up to a maximum of 10 consecutive days. It is important to note that when setting up your account, you must register using the email address and phone number <u>provided to the school during registration.</u>

Bus Transportation Information



Student Transportation Services of York Region (STSYR) is a collaborative venture of the York Catholic and York Region District School boards and provides transportation to more than 53,000 students.

Catholic School Council (CSC)

The education of our children is a shared responsibility which involves schools, students, families and the church. The OLGC Catholic School Council is an advisory council that strives to promote the building of a school community that strengthens the home/school/parish partnership. The council works together as a community of believers committed to putting the values of our faith into practice in the education of our children. Elections to the council are held annually.

The OLGC CSC Elections for the 2024-2025 school year will take place on **Thursday, September 26, 2024, at 6:30 pm** in the school library. It will be an opportunity to elect a Chair or Co-Chairs, Secretary, Treasurer and voting members that shall not exceed 18 members. Successful candidates will hold their elected position for one year and will be expected to attend monthly in person meetings. Membership will be terminated if any Council member misses three (3) consecutive meetings. All parents are welcome to nominate a parent or themselves, attend, and vote. Being a member of the council provides an opportunity to make recommendations to the school, school board and interact with other parents and staff. Nomination forms will be sent out via email shortly. Please fill out the nomination form and return it to the school by <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>September 18, 2024</u>. Communication of candidate's names will be shared by Monday, September 23, 2024. We will proceed with our first council meeting the same evening, unless Elections run late.

School Day Cashless Payment System School-day

We are excited to announce that we will be launching School Day, an online portal that lets us make online payments for events, activities and products. With School Day, you will be able to pay for any school service, product or events i.e. agendas, hot lunch, trips, school spirit wear etc. School Day is easy to use and we appreciate your help in improving cashless payments and significantly reducing the amount of paper our school consumes. We look forward to using this new system, and we hope that you find the School Day portal very useful. An email from the board has been sent with the following information to register your child. Please check your email as a Secure Match Key will allow you to register. Agendas have been set up for Grade 1-3 students and can be paid for using School Day. Please sign up today!!!!

To participate in this exciting initiative, please take a moment to register by following the steps outlined below.

- Please go to the school website home page and click on the School-Day button. Or, go to www.school-day.com
 (or school-day.app for mobile users). Click Log In, and then Register. Complete your information, making sure
 to include a valid email address (a personal email address if you are also an employee of YCDSB), as important
 information and reminders are forwarded from the school to the email you provide.
- 2. Once you make a School-Day account, you need to add a child:
 - a. Click Add Student
 - b. In the Secure-Match™ field, enter your Secure-Match™ Key and then click *Register*.
 - c. Confirm you are the legal parent or guardian of the child.


Please protect your Secure-Match™ Key as it ensures the security of your School-Day profile. Contact your school if this key is misplaced and a replacement key will be provided. Up to two parents/guardians can use the same Secure-Match Key to add a child to their account. If you require an additional key so that another parent/guardian can add a child to their account, please contact your school administrator to have another Secure-Match™ key issued.

1. If you have multiple children, click *Add Student* again, and follow the steps outlined above using the second Secure- Match™ key. You will be able to view all of your children from a single account.

If you require assistance, please contact the School-Day Support Team. You can submit a ticket from within the School-Day system or email support.ticket@school-day.com. You may also call 1.855.253.1731 to leave a voicemail and request a support ticket be opened on your behalf. Cell Phone and Personal Items

At Our Lady of Good Counsel CES, we believe that children should be free of any distractions during the school day. Therefore, all personal items (i.e. toys, trading cards, collections etc.) and electronic devices such as cell phones, smart watches, portable gaming, etc. should NOT be at school. Under certain circumstances where a parent determines that their child must have a cell phone for safety before and after school, it must be powered off and stored out of view in a backpack. Additionally, if the teacher deems it necessary to have a device at any time, they will let you know. The consequences for using cell phones or other electronic devices during school hours will be confiscation of the device. *Please remember that the school is not responsible for the loss, damage, or theft of any item.* Please refer to the parent letter sent out regarding the Ministry of Education Policy PPM 128 on cell phones, vaping and social media.



Threats to Safety Practices

Our Lady of Good Counsel CES has a primary responsibility to ensure the safety of students and staff inside the school building and on school property. <u>Shelter in Place</u>, <u>Hold and Secure</u> and <u>Lockdown</u> represent the three different responses that may be initiated by a school principal in the event of a threat to school safety.

A **Shelter in Place** response is initiated when there is an environmental concern. There is no immediate threat. Students remain in the building and classes continue as usual.

A **Hold and Secure** response is initiated when the threat is proximate to, but not inside the building. The threat poses no immediate danger to students or staff while they remain in the building.

A **Lockdown** response is initiated when imminent danger is present on the school site and the safety of students and staff is threatened.

For all students and staff to become familiar with expectations during a threat to school safety, our school will be practising threat response procedures as well as Fire Drills throughout the school year. During these drills, signs may be posted on the entrance doors indicating that the school is in Shelter in Place, Hold and Secure or Lockdown. The doors may be locked, and no one will be allowed to enter or exit the school.

Cross Country

The cross country meet for grades 4-8 will take place this year on Tuesday, October 8, 2024 at Bruce's Mill Conservation Area. Cross Country forms were distributed at school this past Friday. Please complete the waiver to ensure your child(ren) is able to participate in morning practices on Mondays and Wednesdays beginning at 8:30 am on Monday, September 9, 2024. Thank you to the Cross Country Coaching Team for their time and efforts to hold practices and train our athletes. Go Kodiaks!!
