PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Dear OLGC Families,

We begin the month of April and continue our Lenten journey looking forward to rejoicing and celebrating the resurrection of Jesus Christ and beginning the Easter season. For the month of April, we focus on the virtue of **Reverence**. Lent provides an opportunity to reflect on our lives, our relationship with God, and our actions, fostering a deeper sense of reverence. During Lent, a period of spiritual reflection and renewal, reverence, defined as a feeling of deep respect and awe, can be cultivated through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, deepening our relationship with God.

This 4th Sunday of Lent, Laetare Sunday, marks the halfway point of Lent. On Laetare Sunday (as similarly with the Third Sunday of Advent's Gaudete Sunday) the Church expresses hope and joy in the midst of our Lenten fasts and penances. Marked by pink — or, more fittingly, rose — this change in color indicates a glimpse of the joy that awaits us at Easter, just before we enter into the somber days of Passiontide.

As we embrace the spring months, may we find renewal and rebirth in nature and in our own lives. May we continue to protect the environment and bring awareness especially during Earth Week and Earth Day (April 22). OLGC will be participating in various activities during Earth Week to observe and learn about the Earth and how to be stewards of the Earth.

The staff at Our Lady of Good Counsel CES wish you joy as we continue through Lent looking forward to the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ at Easter!

EARTH DAY - APRIL 22

EQAO Webinar for Parents and Guardians of Elementary School Students

This year our Grade 3 and 6 students will complete the online EQAO assessment between May 20 – June 6, 2025. Register for a free live webinar where EQAO staff will discuss math questions that Ontario students encounter when they participate in Ontario's large-scale assessments. These assessments are taken by all Ontario students in Grades 3, 6 and 9. The next parent webinar is scheduled for **Tuesday**, **April 1**, **2025**, **at 12:00 pm**.



During the webinar, EQAO staff will show how these math questions help assess the skills students are learning in their math classes. School Mental Health Ontario
